PURPOSE

To provide information on Torquay Bowls Club pennant uniform ,dress standards and footwear requirements whilst bowling.

PROCEDURE SCOPE

This procedure applies to all affiliated members of the Torquay Bowls Club and will be enforced by the Bowls Committee.

PROCEDURE INTENT

- All Affiliated members whilst bowling should adhere to all dress, uniform and footwear standards, information or directives from the Bowls Committee or its sub-committees as outlined in this document.
- The Bowls Committee and its sub-committees encourages all bowls participants to adopt a healthy approach to play including the adoption of Club uniform, safe and Sun Smart dress practices.

DETAILED PROCEDURES - UNIFORM & FOOTWEAR

1.1 PENNANT BOWLS

Uniform

All Torquay pennant players must wear the prescribed uniform – specifically the registered club pennant shirt and light royal blue lower garments and a hat which conforms to Bowls Australia requirements and if possible assists adhering to Sun Smart and bowls safety requirements;

This includes:

- a) Torquay pennant shirt (which can be purchased from the club).
- b) Royal blue pants, shorts, 3/4 pants, skorts, skirts with Bowls Australia logo.
- c) Torquay caps are available for purchase from the club for all bowls games including pennant.
- d) All other garments must include the Bowls Australia logo
- e) Where a block hat is worn, this must include a club hatband (available from the club).
- f) A variety of headgear is available from bowls shops ensure that yours has the BA logo and is preferably royal blue or white.
- g) If you have been called up as an emergency but are not a regular pennant player and don't have the correct uniform, you should immediately inform a selector that you need to borrow some items.

Footwear

a) Bowls Shoes or the "OOFOS Original Thong", as approved by Bowls Australia are preferred and encouraged.

2.1 FOR ALL OTHER SANCTIONED BOWLS EVENTS AT THE TBC:

Dress Standards

- a) All Torquay bowlers need to be aware of their personal safety and dress standards on a Bowls green, whilst Bowling.
- b) All players should wear neat casual clothing and if possible a hat that adheres to Sun Smart guidelines.

Footwear

 All Torquay bowlers need to be aware of their personal safety on a Bowls green, approved footwear, as defined below, provides protection (from strike injury and unwanted chemical interaction), support and stability.



Bowls Committee Procedure

• Bowls Shoes or the "OOFOS Original Thong", as approved by Bowls Australia are preferred and encouraged. This procedural requirement will be implemented and enforced by the relevant Bowls sub - committees.

PROCEDURE GOVERNANCE

The Bowls Committee will:

- Review this procedure, annually, prior to the commencement of the season and amend or enhance the procedure where necessary.
